

# PRIVACY POLICY BOERENBRIDGE

Last updated: April 17, 2026

## 1. Introduction

This privacy policy explains how Boerenbridge handles data when the app is used.

Boerenbridge is first and foremost a local score app for Boerenbridge, Oh Hell and related variants. Most data remains on the user's device. Only when the user actively starts or opens a live scoreboard are certain game details temporarily shared through a backend to make live viewing on other devices possible.

We believe it is important to clearly explain what data is processed, why this happens, and what choices and rights users have.

## 3. What data the app may process

### 3.1 Data that may be stored locally on the device

Boerenbridge may store the following data locally on the user's device:

- player names
- groups
- personal scoring systems
- app settings such as language, theme and keeping the screen awake
- in-app preferences such as selected options or saved configurations

This data generally remains local on the user's device.

### 3.2 Data that may be processed for the live scoreboard

When the user actively starts or opens a live scoreboard, the following data may be processed temporarily through the connected backend:

- player names
- selected scoring system
- bids
- number of tricks
- scores
- game progress
- session id
- technical connection data required to make the live session work

This processing takes place solely to enable live sharing of a game across multiple devices.

## 4. Purposes of processing

Boerenbridge processes data only for the following purposes:

- keeping scores and game progress locally

- managing players, groups and personal scoring systems
- saving app settings and preferences
- enabling live scoreboard functionality across multiple devices
- ensuring that the app functions correctly, reliably and securely

## 5. Legal basis for processing

We process data on the following legal grounds:

- performance of the functionality requested by the user: when a user uses the app to keep score, save settings or start a live scoreboard
- legitimate interest: for strictly necessary technical processing required to make the app function correctly, securely and reliably

Boerenbridge does not require account registration in order to use its core functionality.

## 6. Sharing data with third parties

We do not sell personal data to third parties.

Data may only be shared with technical service providers to the extent necessary to operate the app or live scoreboard functionality, for example a hosting or backend provider.

When the live scoreboard is not used, the app is mainly used locally on the device.

## 7. Retention periods

Local data remains stored on the user's device until the user deletes it, removes the app or overwrites the data.

Data processed as part of a live session is not retained longer than necessary for:

- the functioning of the session
- the technical completion of the session
- limited technical logging or error tracking, where applicable

We aim not to retain such data longer than necessary.

## 8. Security

We take reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect data against loss, misuse and unauthorised access.

However, no system can guarantee complete security. Therefore, no absolute guarantee can be given that data will remain fully secure under all circumstances.

## 9. Data relating to minors

Boerenbridge is not specifically directed at children or minors. The app does not require account registration and does not knowingly collect unnecessary personal data from minors.

If a user chooses to enter names or other data into the app, this is done under that user's own responsibility.

## 10. User rights

Depending on applicable law, users may have the right to:

- request information about the processing of their data

- have inaccurate data corrected
- request deletion of data, insofar as this is technically and legally possible
- object to certain types of processing
- request restriction of processing, where applicable
- lodge a complaint with the competent data protection authority

Because Boerenbridge mainly works locally without user accounts, some rights can in practice most easily be exercised by deleting local data in the app or on the device.
